**Footnote 1 about Full-time Tuition:** Undergraduates who enroll in 12-18 academic units per semester are considered full-time, and they are charged a full-time "banded" tuition rate.

**Footnote 2 about Books and Supplies:** In recent years, a student survey conducted by the National Association of College Stores (NACS) has found average spending by students on books to be declining due to increases in the number of students renting their books, shopping competitively online, and using more free materials. In an effort to more accurately estimate the costs of books and supplies, certain IU campuses switched from using data from the College Board to using the NACS survey data starting in 2017-18. By 2019-20, all IU campuses will use the NACS survey results as a basis for estimating costs of books and supplies.

**Footnote 3 about Transportation Costs:** Includes modest commuting costs between the campus and the student's primary residence. For Bloomington, starting in 2017-18, estimated undergraduate transportation costs were lower than in previous years, due to a change in the number of trips home that students typically took. Prior to 2017-18, Bloomington campus residence halls closed during school breaks, leading many students to take more trips between campus and home per semester. Beginning in 2017-18, the Bloomington residence halls have stayed open for students during breaks.

**Footnote 4 about possible rounding errors:** The costs of Tuition and Mandatory Fees are each rounded to the nearest dollar amount before being aggregated and reported above. This methodology is done to replicate how IPEDS collects and publishes this information. As such, reported amounts for Tuition and Mandatory Fees, as well as Total Estimated Costs, may vary slightly from the true costs.
